


“TOGETHER AS ONE”



5. As there was no other business the meeting was closed.


Our Games this time were: The Name Game, Defying Gravity, Balloon Bop, Balloon Relay, Floating on Air, Hide The Hero.

At the HMS Heroes Base, Smuts Road.






